Board and Services Contractual Terms

This agreement is made on _____ between Leatherstocking Equine Center, herein referred to as LEC, and the Mare Owner as listed on the front of this form. In consideration of the mutual promise contained herein, the parties agree to the following terms and conditions regarding the Mare named on the front of this form:

- Mare care shall be at the rate of \$21.00 per day or \$25.00 per day for a mare with foal. Billing is done on the 21st of the month. All board, veterinary and farrier bills shall be paid monthly and shall be paid in full prior to the departure of the Mare.
- Upon arrival, the mare must be halter broken and accompanied with a current Coggins test and proof of current vaccinations. LEC is affiliated with the NYSHHAP program, any required vaccinations not previously given will be administered within 24 hours of arrival at the Owner's expense. LEC has the right to refuse service to any mare which appears ill, diseased or unfit for breeding. LEC staff must be present to admit and release animals. Owner must notify LEC at least 24 hours in advance of delivery or pickup as to approximate arrival/departure time.
- The Owner has inspected and found the facility a safe and acceptable site for Owner's Mare. The Owner shall have the right of access to the Mare during normal business hours, Monday through Friday and at other reasonable times that need to be scheduled with the LEC staff.
- Owner hereby requests and authorizes LEC to perform those procedures normally associated with said Mare's reason for admission. LEC shall have the right to obtain all farrier and veterinary services deemed necessary. These services are the sole responsibility of the Owner and must be paid in full prior to the mare's departure. Breeder shall exercise reasonable care for the health and well being of the said Mare.
- Should an emergency arise, LEC is hereby authorized by Owner to exercise its judgment in rendering whatever medical attention LEC deems prudent. LEC shall, as soon as practical, but without unnecessarily compromising the treatment or comfort of the mare or foal, make reasonable attempts to contact Owner.
- It is hereby agreed that this entire contract, upon execution, when applicable to any Mare with a foal by its side or born at LEC, shall also automatically apply to said offspring upon arrival or birth.
- The Owner waives any and all claims of damages resulting from illness, injury, death, loss or damage to said Mare (and foal) against LEC. The Owner acknowledges that is the custom and usage in the horse breeding and boarding business that all risks of death, sickness, or injury from any source to the mare (and foal) are assumed SOLELY by the Owner. Insurance for mare (and foal), if any, shall be the sole responsibility of the Owner.
- This contract shall be binding when executed and shall be executed in and interpreted under the laws of the State of New York. In any action arising out of the provisions of this agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees and costs. A party shall be deemed a prevailing party for the purpose of this agreement if judgement is rendered in his or her favor or where the litigation is dismissed in his or her favor prior to, or during the trial, unless the parties otherwise agree to the settlement or compromise.
